WHEREAS City of Timmins By-law No. 1983-2004 provides for the regulation of traffic; and

WHEREAS it is considered desirable to amend City of Timmins By-law No. 1983-2004.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the City of Timmins enacts the following as a By-law:

1. THAT Part 1 – Definitions for the Purpose of this By-law be amended to <u>add</u> the following:

YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS: Drivers, including cyclists, must yield to pedestrians (stop or get off your bike) – Book 18 HTA

- 2. THAT **Part IV Operation of vehicles**, Section 32 (c) (2) (1) Cycling be amended to <u>add</u> the following:
 - (e) Cycling is allowed on sidewalk on the west side of Theriault Boulevard south of Vimy Street to Avenue Road:
 - (f) Cycling is allowed on the sidewalk on the north side of Algonquin Blvd. from Avenue Road to the most easterly portion of Riverside Drive (600 Riverside Drive);
 - (g) Cycling is allowed on sidewalk on the north side of Riverside Drive from Shirley Street to Government Road
- 3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect when a properly worded signage has been erected indicating the traffic restriction.

READ a first and second time this 27 day of June, 2023.

READ a third and final time and enacted and passed this 27 day of June. 2023.

 - (f) Cycling is allowed on the sidewalk on the north side of Algonquin Blvd. from Avenue Road to the most easterly portion of Riverside Drive (600 Riverside Drive):
 - (g) Cycling is allowed on sidewalk on the north side of Riverside Drive from Shirley Street to Government Road
- 3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and effect when a properly worded signage has been erected indicating the traffic restriction.
